340B Prescription Program

Community Health Centers of Greater Dayton (CHCGD) participates in a program that helps our patients receive discounts on prescription medications.

Participation in the program can save patients 20% - 50% on the cost of prescription medications

It's easy to start saving—no paperwork or applications necessary!

- Uninsured patients may be able to obtain medications at a significantly discounted rate through this program.
- If you have commercial insurance coverage, using this program
 can help you too. If a medication is not covered by your insurance
 carrier, you are eligible for the discounted cash price at our
 partner pharmacies.
- Patients with Medicaid, including Buckeye, CareSource, Molina, Paramount, and UHC, will <u>not</u> receive any savings under this program because medications are already discounted.
