Catholic Social Services' Choice Food Pantry serves residents of neighborhoods in west and northwest Dayton with especially high rates of poverty, unemployment and underemployment. Consumers can choose food for approximately five days per referral, every 30 days. Eligibility requirements include address verification (utility or other bill received within the past 30 days), a picture ID for the head of household and identification for everyone living in the house (photo I.D. for adults, insurance cards for children). The pantry serves the following zip codes: 45402, 45405, 45406, 45417 and 45428. A Virtual Case Manager is utilized to facilitate the intake process and assist with community referrals.
