

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How do I become a new patient of Community Health Centers of Greater Dayton (CHCGD)?

A: Contact the Appointment Line at 937-461-6869 to obtain a new patient registration form and to schedule an appointment.

Q: Do I need an appointment or can I just walk in?

A: We typically see patients by appointment only. You can schedule an appointment for any of our locations by calling our Appointment Line.

Q: Do you accept uninsured patients?

A: We do accept uninsured patients; however we do not provide free services. The services for uninsured patients are provided at a discount based on their family size and income. The Sliding Fee Scale brochure and Sliding Fee Scale Application can be downloaded from the Patients tab on our website or obtained at any of our Health Centers.

Q: Can I access my health records online?

A: Yes. Once you are a patient you will receive a token ID then you can access our health portal at www.nextmd.com

A: Call your center and follow the instructions to reach the provider on call.
