Need Help Paying Your Summer Electric Bills?

The Summer Crisis Program may be able to help!

The Summer Crisis Program is available **July 1 through September 30** to households at or below 175% of the federal poverty level that also meet **ONE** of the following requirements:

- A household member is 60 or older; OR
- A household member has a medical necessity documented by a qualified medical professional; OR
- The household has an electricity disconnection notice, has been shut off, or new electric service is being established.

Eligible PIPP Plus customers can get help with their default payment under PIPP Plus. The program is also available to electric consumers of investor-owned utilities, municipal utilities, and rural electric co-ops.
